Applicants must submit:

- An application form (see next page),
- Copies of unofficial transcripts from your current educational program,
- A certificate of enrollment from your university's registrar's office,
- A copy of your current resume,
- Two letters of recommendation mailed directly to our Foundation offices, and a
- 10 to 15-minute video that includes your story (e.g., what life experiences brought you to your chosen field), your professional experiences (work, volunteer, and internship), your financial need (how would this scholarship alleviate financial stress and help you in completing your educational program), and your professional and personal aspirations post-graduation.

Applications are due by May 30th of each year. Scholarship funds will be sent to the recipient's university Financial Aid office by August of the same year.
