<p>To qualify for our Social Work scholarship, students must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • be enrolled in a CSWE-accredited Bachelor or Master of Social Work program, • be in their second semester/quarter or beyond at the time of application, • have earned a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher, • have an interest in directly serving their community or have an interest in advocating for policy and/or legislative changes, and • demonstrate financial need. 	<p>To qualify for our Educators scholarship, students must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • be enrolled in an accredited Bachelor or Master of Teaching program, • be in their second semester/quarter or beyond at the time of application, • have earned a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher, • have an interest in teaching at a K-12 level, and • demonstrate financial need. <p>Preferred:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicants who have a desire to serve an underserved or under resourced community.
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Students interested in applying for either scholarship must submit:

- An application form (see next page),
- Copies of unofficial transcripts from their current educational program,
- A certificate of enrollment from their university registrar office,
- A copy of their current resume,
- Two letters of recommendation mailed directly to our Foundation offices (address below), and a
- 10 to 15-minute video telling their story (e.g., what life experiences brought you to your chosen field), your professional experiences (work, volunteer, and internship) thus far, your financial need (how would this scholarship alleviate financial stress and help you in completing your educational program), and your professional and personal aspirations post-graduation.

Applications are due by May 30th of each year. Scholarship funds will be sent to the students' university Financial Aid office by August of the same year.
