## CLINICAL SUPERVISION

Hours provided to 3 provisionally licensed Social Workers (one of which is now a fully licensed Clinical Social Worker)

## NONPROFIT GRANTS

### Lander Free Medical Clinic (WY)

No-cost medical care for uninsured adults.

### Navajo Nation Project (UT)

Food, clothing, and educational materials for families on the Montezuma Creek Reservation.

### Gerald's House (NM)

Grief care services for children and families.

### Project Sleep Tight (AZ)

Totes with essential supplies for homeless youth.

## STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

A \$1000 academic scholarship was awarded to a high-achieving Social Work program student at BYU Hawaii.

## COMMUNITY PARTNERS SUPPORT

- Provided consulting to a private therapy practice in Colorado Springs, assisted with billing and credentialing so they could increase access to care for their community
- Provided free resources and education to a newer private practice in Colorado Springs to improve the competency of their therapist to work with survivors of Domestic Violence
- Provided subsidized consulting to two LCSWs for 4 hours (saving them \$200) on complex cases, navigating community resources, and insurance credentialing questions)
